

# Sale of Chametz

Also, these forms should be sent or given directly either to the Rabbi or Mary at the synagogue office. This will minimize their risk of being misplaced. You can also call the Rabbi by telephone and describe all the items on the form.

## Ma'ot Hittin

It is customary to contribute to a communal fund before *Pesah* in order that everyone can afford a kosher *Pesach*. Contributions may be made to the Rabbi when you appoint him your agent for the sale of your *chametz*. He shall pass these funds on to appropriate agencies.

**Please note:** Please realize that it is important, when you sell the leavened goods, to move them to an area **outside** of the kitchen. Only "Hametzdik" pots, pans and utensils can be stored (and sealed away) in the kitchen. Food must be stored and sealed away elsewhere in the house and you may not enter that area all during Passover. If you must place it in a room in which access is important, it may be cordoned by a partition. The packages of food should not be visible.

**\*Please note it is customary to provide "Maothittim" some money for the needy at this time**
